Rules & Conditions:

1. The Competition is open to all children in Gibraltar between year 4 and year 13.
2. There are two themes:
 - a. Submissions from those years 4 to 7 must be on the title:
'The Place where I live'.
Entries are project based and could be in the form of a picture, poem, project or short essay or narrative (max 600 words) or even an interview with a family member on their memories of life in Gibraltar. Supporting photographs or drawings are welcome.
 - b. Submissions from those years 8 to 13 must be in essay form:
'What is Gibraltar's Heritage and why is it important?'
Maximum length 1500 words. Supporting photographs or drawings are welcome.
3. Where relevant entries should be word processed on A4 paper and must keep to the word limit set for the appropriate age range as set in paragraph 2 above. All stories should carry at least one picture or illustration.
4. Only one entry may be submitted per child.
5. Work, photographs and illustrations must be original; entirely the author's own work; not infringe on the copyright or any other rights of any third party nor be defamatory in any way.
6. All entries will become the property of the Gibraltar Heritage Trust.
7. A panel of judges will judge the competition. The Judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. There will be 2 prize categories based on age group as follows:
 - A. Years 4 to 7: 'The place where I live'
 - B. Years 8 to 13: 'What is Gibraltar's Heritage and why is it important?'
9. The winner in each category will receive a £50 voucher and a Gibraltar Heritage Trust goody bag.
10. All winning entries will be printed in the Gibraltar Heritage Journal.
11. The Gibraltar Heritage Trust reserves the right to cancel this competition at any stage if deemed necessary in its opinion and if circumstances arise out of its control.
