HERITAGE AWARD 2010

CONDITIONS AND NOMINATION FORM

The Gibraltar Heritage Trust invites nominations on the accompanying form for the Heritage Awards for 2010. The award will be for any achievements during the past five years, ie 2005 to 2009 inclusive.

The awards will be made for outstanding sensitivity or contribution to Gibraltar's heritage. They may be made to an individual (including juniors under the age of 16), group, team, club, firm or company for a positive contribution, of any kind, that has enhanced Gibraltar's heritage, or for exceptional, successful efforts in preserving a part of our heritage. (Examples of the former could be a building, a written work, a piece of research or a work of art; and of the latter an important tree or trees that would otherwise have been cut down, a historic wall or building that would otherwise have been demolished, or important records that might otherwise have been lost; but other achievements will also be considered).

The winners will be selected by the Board of Trustees from nominations submitted by the public. The Trust will reserve the right not to make any award in any one year if none of the candidates proposed are considered to have met the required standard. The Board's decision will be final.

Nominations should be made on the accompanying form and on the basis of these, the Trustees will draw up a short list. Those who have nominated the candidates that reach the short list may then be invited to provide further details of the achievement, and these would be used for the final selection.

The nomination should be for an achievement during the past five years, i.e. 2005 to 2009 inclusive.

Closing date for the nominations, which should be returned to the Trust's office in a sealed envelope marked "NOMINATION FOR HERITAGE AWARD", is **Wednesday 10th March 2010**.
