**PAINTING/DRAWING COMPETITION – SATURDAY 15th MAY 2010– EUROPA POINT
RULES**

1. All entries must feature any aspect of **Europa Point** from any vantage point.
2. Paintings/Drawings may be carried out using different artistic media.
3. Painting/Drawing must take place on site between **9:00am** and **5pm** on **Saturday 15th May**.
4. All entries must be unsigned and bear no identification on the front. The participant's name and address must be printed on the back.
5. Registration will take place on site between **9.00am** and **12pm**. Entries will be stamped on registration. Only entries bearing the **official stamp** of the **GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST** will be considered.
6. Participants may submit a total of two entries.
7. Entries should **not** be larger than 76cm x 60cm.
8. The GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST does not hold itself responsible for any accident, damage to or loss of property that may be incurred by any participant.
9. Participants must ensure that they cause no damage whatsoever to the site.
10. Completed entries should be handed in at the **Trust Offices** at **13 John Mackintosh Square** by **5.15pm** on the day. No entries will be accepted after this time.
11. The Trust will not be responsible for the supervision of participants in the children's section.
12. Prizes will be as follows:-

14. The GIBRALTAR HERITAGE TRUST will keep all winning entries, which will be used by the Trust as it sees fit.
15. Any non-winning entries not collected from the Trust's Office within three months after the date of the competition will become property of the Trust for use as the Trust sees fit.

The announcement of winners and presentation of prizes by HE The Governor, Sir Adrian Johns, will take place at the official opening of the exhibition of all entries on **Tuesday 18th May** at **6pm** at the Trust's Office at 13 John Mackintosh Square. All participants are invited to attend. (No individual invitations will be issued to participants).
